
Downloading files from Windows

You can use the **Copy** command in the Windows **File Manager** to download PostScript files to the printer.

- Locate the files you want to use on the Windows 3.1 Driver and Printer Utilities diskette. You may want to copy the files from the diskette to your hard disk if you plan to use them often.
- In Windows, double-click the File Manager icon in the Main window.
- 3. Locate the drive and directory or subdirectory containing the printer's utility files.
- Select the utility file you want to send to the printer, for example RESET.PS.
- 5. From the **File** menu, select **Copy**. The **Copy** dialog box appears with the utility file you selected listed in the **From** field.



- In the To field, type the port your printer is connected to. For example, type LPT1: for a parallel port connection. Choose the OK button.
- If the Confirm File Replace dialog box appears, choose the Yes button to continue.
 The file is downloaded to the printer.
